## RESOLUTION TO RATIFY AND APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR POLICIES EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1, 2023

- WHEREAS, On July 21, 2022, the Board of Library Trustees authorized the renewal of the insurance packages stated within the Resolution for four, one-year renewal periods commencing on August 1, 2023, provided that terms, conditions, and pricing remain comparable to the current programs and consistent with then-current market conditions; and
- WHEREAS, On June 15, 2023, the Board of Library Trustees authorized the Executive Director to make the final determination to accept the insurance package that provides the best coverage for the lowest overall cost, for a total annual premium for all policies not to exceed \$638,000, and the coverage purchased would be presented for ratification by the Board of Library Trustees at their next regularly scheduled meeting; and
