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

The Mobile Shelving Project is 100% on schedule and is approximately 50% completed.

- March 1, 2023: Project started
- January 16, 2024: Installation on LSW 7 is 98% completed
- January 17 February 16, 2024: LSW 8 installation (projected)
- February 19 November 1, 2024: LSW 9 installation (projected)

Budget

The CPL Board of Trustees approved a budget of \$6,057,792.50 and a contingency fund of \$605,779 on December 16, 2021.

- Invoiced through 12/31/2023: \$3,090,116.53
- Remaining: \$2,906,882.86 (48%)
- Change Orders 1-12 resulted in a net increase of \$112,863.20
 (1.9% of project budget)

Change Orders

Largest *Decreases* to Original Contract Amount:

- Change Order 12: (\$153,029.80) credit for 8,672 re-used metal shelves
- Change Order 5: (\$51,540.00) credit for changing touch-screen controller to push-button due to shortage of computer chips

Largest Increases to Original Contract Amount:

- Change Order 7: \$247,802.00 for adding integral LED lights to existing mobile shelving on LSW 8 to update fluorescent fixtures and correct 30 aisles/areas with no direct lighting due to original lighting design flaw. (Comparison: Feghali Brothers' winning ceiling work bid 9/22/2022 ("Option 1") to convert existing ceiling fixtures to LED was \$325,000 and did *not* include re-engineering lighting on LSW 8 to correct 30 dark aisles/areas.)
- Change Order 9: \$59,072.00 for additional custom map cabinets for increased collection capacity, as requested by the Manager of the Center for Local & Global History

Shelving Capacity – The Numbers

Before

- LSW 7: 28,329 linear feet (5.4 miles)
- LSW 8: 35,274 linear feet (6.7 miles)*
- LSW 9: 15,123 linear feet (2.9 miles)
- TOTAL LSW 7-9: 78,726 linear feet (14.9 miles)
 About 882,000 volume capacity (@ 11.2015 books/foot)
- TOTAL OFFSITE STORAGE: 74,715 linear feet (14.2 miles)
- GRAND TOTAL CAPACITY (LSW 7-9 AND Offsite Storage): 153,441 linear feet (29.1 miles)

*LSW 8 had existing mobile shelving since 1997 except in NE & SE corner areas. The overall increase on LSW 8 (NE & SE areas) is projected to be 3,818 linear feet or .85 linear miles, which is enough capacity for about 40,000 volumes.


After

- LSW 7: 63,958 linear feet (12.11 miles)**
- LSW 8: 39,092 linear feet (7.4 miles)*
- LSW 9: 75,744 linear feet (14.35 miles)**
- TOTAL INCREASED CAPACITY LSW 7-9: +100,068 linear feet (+19 miles)
 - Increased capacity of about 1,121,000 volumes
- GRAND TOTAL CAPACITY (LSW 7-9): 178,794 linear feet (33.86 miles; capacity for about 2 million vols +/-)

**Figures do not include folio shelves to be added to LSW 7 (+1,300 shelves) and LSW 9 (+338 shelves), nor do they include cabinets (map, filing, fiche) that were moved to LSW 7.

Move Statistics

Books moved within LSW 7:

•23,200 linear feet of book volumes

•260,000 volumes (ESTIMATE based on extensive statistical sample with +/- 3% margin of error; average 11.2015 vols per foot)

•465,000 volumes counting multiple moves of same item

(22% of 260,000 volumes moved three times; 35% moved twice; 43% moved once)

Books moved from LSW 9 to LSW 7:

•12,200 linear feet of book volumes (100% moved once)

•137,000 volumes (ESTIMATE based on extensive statistical sample with +/- 3% margin of error; average 11.2015 vols per foot)

GRAND TOTAL (LSW 7 & 9): 397,000 volumes (602,000 counting multiple moves of same item)

(14% of 397,000 volumes moved three times; 23% moved twice; 63% moved once)

Filing cabinets (LSW 8 to LSW 7): 63 Microfiche cabinets (LSW 8 to LSW 7): 48 Map cases (LSW 9 to LSW 7): 18 Superman telephone booths (LSW 9 to LSW 7): 1

Other Statistics

- Old shelves re-used in new mobile shelving (so far): 8,672
- Steel recycled from old shelving (so far):
 - 35,960 pounds (18 tons)
