RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT CLEVELAND FOUNDATION GRANT FOR THE YOUTH TRANSITIONS COMPONENT OF THE MYCOM INITIATIVE

- WHEREAS, The MyCom initiative provides support and opportunities for youth throughout their childhood and adolescence, and across the settings where they spend their time (family/home, school, out-of-school time (OST) programs, and community); and
- WHEREAS, The Library, under an agreement with the Cuyahoga County
 Commissioners' Family and Children First Council, is the MyCom Lead
 Agency for Transitions and will provide programs for youth pre-K to 12
 that help youth transition from pre-school to kindergarten, 3rd grade to 4th
 grade, middle to high school, and high school to adulthood; and
- WHEREAS, The Cleveland Foundation has made available grant funds in order to accomplish the goals set forth in the Transitions work plan, developed by the Library and MyCom; and
- WHEREAS, The Cleveland Foundation funds will be used to: place informational kiosks in selected library neighborhood branches; offer workshops for high school students to assist them in transitioning into post-secondary education; and a program to provide educational support for third grade students; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED, The Cleveland Public Library Board of Trustees accepts the \$73,000.00 grant from the Cleveland Foundation for the Youth Transitions Component of the MyCom Initiative.
