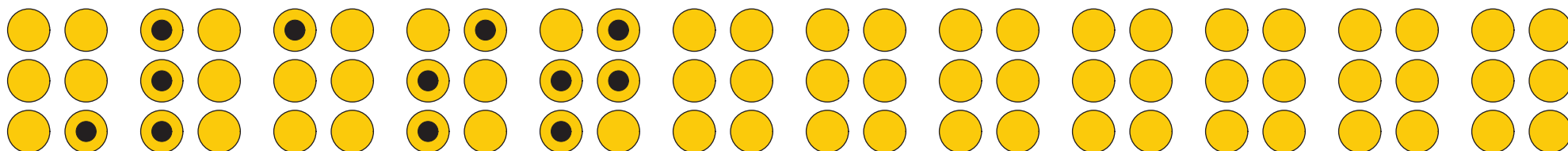
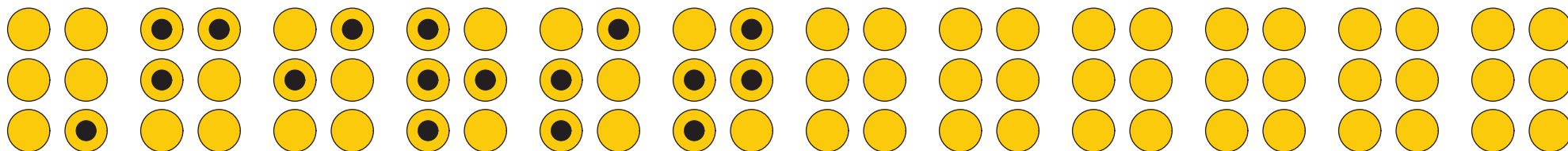


THE BRAILLE NAME GAME

Braille is a system of touch reading and writing invented by Louis Braille in 1821. The braille cell is an arrangement of six dots, numbered downward 1-2-3 in the first or left column, and 4-5-6 in the second or right column. Dot 6 placed before a letter makes a capital letter.
